He holds a PhD from McGill, is a licensed P.Eng in B.C., and is active in CDA, and CIM. He has volunteered widely, including with CDA, MAC, CIM, SME, ICMM, and ICOLD Chile. He is a recipient of the CDA 2023 Peter Halliday Award for Service, and an Honorary Member of ROCOLD and the Technical Sciences Academy of Romania. He currently leads the development of a new ICOLD Bulletin on Tailings and Embankment Dam Surveillance (draft expected in Q4 2027).
